Pastor's Letter

Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord"; and she told them that he had said these things to her. - John 20:8

Most befittingly, the month of April starts with April's Fools Day and Easter! For centuries, "Holy Humor Sunday" has been a tradition across the Christian faith. Typically held the week after Easter, the faithful celebrate Jesus' trick on death with parties, picnics, jokes, and laughter. Mary Magdalene's statement, "I have seen the Lord" communicates awe, disbelief, fear, and hope. But most of all, it's filled with unashamed joy. And so, we are Easter people! People held together with the common belief in Jesus' resurrection and what it means for our lives.

April is also the time of spring and new life. When the temperature starts to rise and the flowers bloom, there is a palpable sense of hope and expectation. With school year winding down and summer approaching, we embark on another season in our lives. Wherever April finds you, I am praying for your emotional, spiritual, and physical health. I am praying for peace and love for you and yours. Know that God loves you and is the source of all new and resurrected life.

Although I'm currently participating in the praise band, my first love is traditional hymns. One of my favorites is "Easter People, Raise Your Voices". I can't sing it without smiling. Did you know that in the United Methodist Church, the Easter season is 50 days long? We are still celebrating after the last note of Easter worship. In fact, we are always celebrating Easter. We are Easter People!

"Easter People, Raise Your Voices" was written by the Rev William Marceus James (1913-2013). While the pastor of Metropolitan Community United Methodist Church in Harlem, NY, Rev James wrote over 50 hymns. "He also organized the East Harlem Triangle Housing Program, founded the Ministerial Interfaith Association of Harlem, and ministered to street gangs and the homeless. He was chairman of the board of the Harlem Urban Development Corporation that helped save the famed Apollo Theater from abandonment and rebuilt the structure of the Harlem community." According to the article posted below, "William James' ministry and his 97 years of life reflected his belief in the power of the Resurrection to make a difference in the lives of those whom he served."

My prayer for April is that we live as Easter People. My prayer is that we are strengthened and emboldened by the power of the Resurrection. My prayer is that we find peace, joy, and encouragement during this season.

Endowment Distribution– Projects requested

Our endowment funds held at the Iowa United Methodist Foundation earned an exceptional return in 2017. In accordance with our endowment policy, the Endowment Ministry Team requested, and the Church Council approved, a distribution of \$10,000 from the endowment funds. Endowment distributions typically are used for special projects or ministries that are not part of the church's annual budget.

The Church Council will act to approve one or more specific uses of this year's distribution at its meeting in June. In order to be eligible to receive funds from the endowment, the Council agreed on the following procedures and asks everyone wishing to request funds to follow them:

All the UCMCV program ministries (Missions, Education, Evangelism, Youth, Stewardship, Worship, Memorials, Membership Care, Peace/Justice) and administrative ministries (Trustees, Staff Parish, Finance, Lay Leadership) are eligible to request funds from the distribution.

If there is a request or idea for use of the funds from an individual in the congregation, it must first go through one of the program or administrative ministry teams above.

All requests must include the following:

- name of the project/program/event, etc. to be funded with this distribution
- name of the Council member or committee making the request
- description of what outcome is expected
- estimated cost
- availability of other funding sources if full funding from endowment is not possible

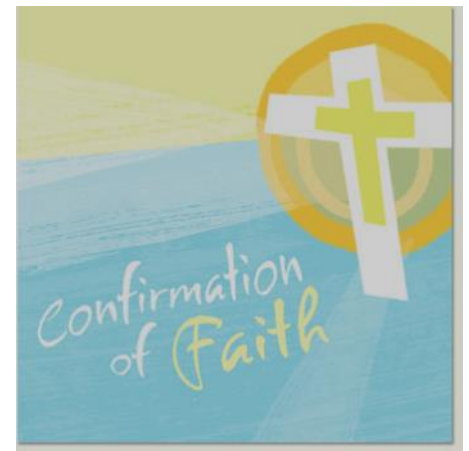
All requests should be sent to Alison Dix in the church office by June 1. The requests will be presented to the Council at its June meeting for discussion and a vote for selection.

Pastor Lee from Women @ the Well Visiting Sunday April 15

Did you know the church is in prison? Women at the Well is our sister congregation, a United Methodist congregation within the walls of the women's correctional institution in Mitchellville, Iowa. The pastor of this ministry, Rev. Lee Schott, will be with us on Sunday, **April 15**, to share with us about the ten years of weekly worship, supportive community, faith nurture groups, and aftercare we have offered to the women there. Maybe you'll find your own place in prison—in ministry with these women, our sisters in Christ.

Pastor Lee has been transformed by her connection with women (criminals!) of amazing resilience, faith and wisdom, as they navigate overwhelming obstacles. She is a frequent speaker outside the prison and the author of a forthcoming book, *Learning Church Where We Did Not Mean to Go*, which offers lessons for the church in the world, based on her experience of church inside the prison.

Lee resides with her husband on her family's century farm near Prairie City, Iowa. They are the parents of three sons and a dear daughter-in-law.
