Pastor's Letter

Dear Friends.

What a gift it is to worship together, as we dive more deeply into the season of Lent. March is the month that is centered in Lent this year, a season of reflection and preparation. We began with Ash Wednesday, remembering that we were but dust, and to dust we would return. We moved from this right into Acts 2:42-47, a passage of scripture dedicated to the discussion of the fellowship of believers, for the purpose of reflecting on our own fellowship with one another and with our God, the Almighty. I would encourage you to pay attention this month. Look for Christ in the eyes of another believer. Look for Christ in the center of all that you find. Look for Christ everywhere you turn. Pay attention to the prompting of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit was sent to strengthen, lead and guide you and I.

^{2:42-47} They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. Awe came upon everyone, because many wonders and signs were being done by the apostles. All who believed were together and had all things in common; they would sell their possessions and goods and distribute the proceeds to all, as any had need. Day by day, as they spent much time together in the temple, they broke bread at home and ate their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having the goodwill of all the people. And day by day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved.

This scripture focuses on the movement of worship for the early church. What stands out to you? How is it that your life reflects this movement day by day? Do you recognize the holiness in something as simple and ordinary as sharing a meal with friends? Do you recognize the holiness in sharing with one another? Do you recognize the Holiness in the Awe that comes among all believers? Worship God each and every day. Keep paying attention.

The last Sunday in March will bring us to Palm Sunday where we will celebrate with Jesus, this will take us into Holy Week, where we will have an opportunity to celebrate the Last Supper, Good Friday, and then on the First of April, the great resurrection of our Lord and Savior! You won't want to miss it. It is all glorious indeed.

Keep leaning in, my friends. We are praying for you as we grow together in faith.



ENDOWMENT FUND

Endowment update Fourth quarter 2017

The church's endowment funds, most of which are managed by the Iowa United Methodist Foundation (IUMF), benefited from strong market performance in 2017, and earned a return of about 11% for the year. The assets managed by IUMF have increased by about \$70,000 since the account was instituted in 2011. Endowment funds in all accounts totaled about \$225,000 at yearend.

The Endowment Ministry Team will recommend a distribution of some of the profit on our investments to the Church Council at its next meeting. If the Council approves the distribution, they also make the final decision as to how it will be used to further the ministry of the church.

The Endowment Ministry Team gratefully accepts bequests and other legacy gifts from members and friends of the church. A gift to endowment "keeps on giving," since the principal of the endowment is never spent; only a portion of the income is distributed, so that the endowment funds can support the church in perpetuity, leaving a legacy to our children's children. Endowment is forever!



Among Friends: A Dramatic Adaptation of the Last Supper Sunday March 25 at 7:00 pm

Wander past our sanctuary doors any Sunday afternoon right now and you are likely to hear men debating rather loudly. It might even sound as if they are arguing. Not to worry. It is thirteen courageous men from our church family, rehearsing the play "Among Friends" written by Dennis Damon-Moore, formerly a member of our congregation. This is a dramatization of the Last Supper drawn from

materials in the four Gospel accounts. After much study of the scriptures, Damon-Moore set out to record his impression of what the conversation around the table might have been. This short play is scheduled to be performed in our sanctuary on Palm Sunday evening, March 25, at 7 p.m.

The dramatization was originally presented in our church in 2000 when Damon-Moore was then the Academic Dean of Cornell and he and his family were members of our church. It has since been repeated in 2006 and 2013. It seemed to be time again to bring it back to life. Always before, it was given on Maundy Thursday evening. In order to make it available to members of our neighboring congregations who have their own services on that night, it has been decided this year to present it on a Sunday evening as a gift to our communities.

Members of the cast are Jeremy Hotz, John McWilliams, Kraig Hunter, Eric Briesemeister, Matt Stewart, Cot Graber, Terry Pisarik, Todd Lineberg, Rik Smith, Bill Micheel, Dan Hakken, Paul Tuerler portraying the twelve disciples. John Bixler will portray Jesus. Barb Shepley is doing the costuming and Babs Moore is directing.

This presentation is guaranteed to add a profound meaning to your Holy Week and Easter. It is free and open to the public. Be sure to mark your calendars for March 25 and invite your friends and neighbors. You will be glad you did and they will thank you!!

The Great Commission; transit to Transylvania!

Jesus gave us the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20), his last recorded instructions given to us in the Bible. It is a command, not a suggestion! Our UMC mission statement is based on these vitally important words In essence, Jesus is telling us we have great news and we can't keep it to ourselves. Yes!

18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Do you notice how this command is both relational and verb-filled? Jesus is talking to his beloved disciples (then and now) with the authority granted to Him by His Father. He is talking about the relationship of the Trinity, and God's love of all peoples; every tribe, tongue and nation. He uses verbs like "go", "make", "baptize", "teach". He closes with an assurance of his constant presence until the close of the age. Such a powerful command so full of hope and love for all people!

We get to participate in The Great Commission as we love on The Super Kids Day Center and its staff. The children attending have very limited access to the Gospel; many have not experienced true love or have ever heard of Jesus. Pastor Cristi, his wife Ligia, and social worker Kiki have heard a call to start this day center from nothing, in a city that is foreign to them. They are working against great odds and have felt isolated in their ministry with poor and abandoned children. There are six people from our congregation who will visit Romania

May 14-21: Kim Ott, Natalie Ott, Allison Ott, Karen Stoll, Ray and Nancy Reasland. Our purpose is 4-fold:

1. Build a supportive and encouraging relationship between UMCMV and the staff of the Super Kids Day Center.

2. Share God's love and encouragement with the children of the Super Kids Day Center.

3. Determine how UMCMV can best support The Super Kids Day Center in their on-going mission.

4. Create a culture of goers and senders in UMCMV that will allow us to live into our mission statement in a real and tangible way.



What Is Scrip?

Scrip is a term that means "substitute money". When you purchase scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for our organization.

How scrip generates revenue for UMCMV

The Great Lakes Scrip Center acts on behalf of churches, schools and other non-profit organizations to purchase large amounts of scrip from grocery stores, department stores, and other retailers. Because the scrip is purchased with cash up front, the participating retailers offer a substantial discount. Our church buys the scrip from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a discount (and also from local participating businesses), and re-sells the certificates to families like yours for full face value. The discount - from two to fifteen percent or more — is UMCMV's revenue.

Scrip is "shopping cart fundraising"

Scrip is a popular fundraiser because families don't have to sell anything. Organization members produce revenue by making regular household purchases they <u>would make anyway</u>. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with scrip.

The order form to the right is a sample of retailers that participate in the Scrip program. There is a complete list of all retailers (over 500) available from the church office. Please feel free to write in other participating retailers not on the form. Return completed orders to the church office, or drop them in the collection plate. Checks should be made out to UMC of MV-Scrip. Orders will be placed on the 1st and 15th of each month. Gift Cards should be received in the church office 5-7 days from the order date. Those who order will be notified when the Gift Cards are received.
