Pastor's Letter

But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb... (Luke 24:1-2)

Dear Friends,

This season on the life of the United Methodist Church is a difficult one. People have been hurt, all across the spectrum of conversation. I am grieved by this. I am grieved by the broken relationships, and that many feel forced to take sides against the brothers and sisters we have been worshipping with for years. I have wept. I have wept for Jesus Christ, and the pain he has felt as he has watched us hurt one another. I have wept as I have considered the broken relationships, the lies that have been told, and the narrative that we find ourselves listening to. I weep as I hear that there are people that don't think I would like to hear what they have to say. Hear this from me, I want to hear from you. I want to listen to your stories, and your thoughts. If you want to talk, I want to listen. I weep as I consider how we have lost our focus on our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

This month, we will continue to listen to the words of Jesus, we will listen in as he speaks to his disciples and the people he ministers to, we will consider his excruciating death on the cross. The death where he took on all of our sin, shame, guilt, and pain. We will grieve. Three days later we will celebrate, as we realize the power of our great God. As we consider the love of our Father in Heaven who raised our savior from the dead, we will be reminded what a great Lord we have. We will once again remember the power of transformation available to us. I continue to be amazed at the power and love of my savior. I for one do not feel worthy, but am honored to be a servant of Christ, and my life has been transformed by my savior, and continues to be.

We have a Church Council meeting on Monday night, April 1st. We will have some very real conversations about where we are as a church, making sure we are all on the same page following the Special General Conference of 2019. Let's consider all of the ways we can lean into sharing how Jesus Christ has made a difference in our lives. Let's lean into sharing our joy, our hope, and our peace with others. Let's lean into discipleship. For it is God that gives us the strength we need to lean in. It is our Father in Heaven who offers us unconditional love. Unconditional love doesn't mean we agree on everything. Consider those you consider closest to you, I bet with the 10 people you would consider closest to you, there are things you disagree about, but love remains. Let's lean into the things we agree on, let's worship our savior, let's invite the Holy Spirit to minister to our souls and our spirits, our minds and our hearts as the great advocate, comforter, and redeemer.

We will soon celebrate the resurrection. It is because of this resurrection that we know we can be set free from all that holds us down. We can be set free from the fear that holds us bondage, we can be set free of poor life decisions, we can be set free from addictions, we can find a way of hope that breaks us out of depression and anguish, we can be set free to find a peace that goes beyond the narrative of the world, and walks only through the narrative of Christ, our redeemer, our savior, and the one who rose to set us free.

The Sunday immediately following Easter will be Servant Sunday, and it will be a wonderful day to worship together. The first Sunday in May we will start a new sermon series entitled: Faithfulness. We will look at the different ways that God is faithful, and has been faithful throughout history and the ways that we can be faithful in return. We will look to scripture: the inspired, authoritative word of God for our direction and leading, and we will connect those scriptures to our daily experiences. It will be a blessing and a gift. I hope you will join us!





UNITED METHODIST WOMEN UPDATE



The local unit of the United Methodist Church of Mount Vernon has made the decision to disband. This was a sad and difficult decision after having had a UMW unit in our church for many years. For 150 years the focus of United Methodist Women has always been on mission, especially those projects involving women, children and youth locally and around the world. Many factors have contributed to our active membership decline as the focus for our members has been pulled in many directions by societal changes.

So what does this mean for our local church? The United Methodist Women usually took care of providing food and serving for dinners and receptions. This group also furnished supplies for the kitchen like dishes, coffee makers, roasters, and appliances, etc. These needs will now go to the congregation and the trustees. We will have in place an event coordinator who will determine needs and call on help from the congregation to provide food, set-up and serving funeral luncheons or receptions. The Trustees will take care of the major upkeep of appliances.

A new kitchen fund will be established with about \$500 from the United Methodist Women as seed money. Any additional donations from serving luncheons, community event use or individuals will go to help with costs of kitchen needs in the future.

We, the board members of the United Methodist Women, were saddened to come to this decision, but felt it's time make a change. We ask that the congregation be aware of the changes and when a call comes out for food or help with an event, please do what you can as a service to our church. 
